

I have been going to Bridgercare for the last 12 years, ever since I was a freshman at Montana State University. I first chose Bridgercare because of their sliding fee scale. During college, I had a part time job at the mall so the sliding fee scale was what I relied on for affordable birth control and wellness exams. I continued to go to Bridgercare after college because of the compassionate and knowledgeable staff. Even though I no longer needed the sliding fee scale, I chose to go to Bridgercare because they always made me feel so comfortable and took the time to answer all of my questions. In 2016, during my annual exam, I had an abnormal pap result, which meant I was at the highest risk for developing cervical cancer in the future. Bridgercare performed my first colposcopy, and then made the referral for my LEEP treatment, which cleared up all the precancerous cells on my cervix. Since then, I have had clear margins, and just over a year ago, I gave birth to a healthy little boy named Nicholas. I am so grateful for the care I have received at Bridgercare! They have been there for me every step of the way, and I just cannot thank them enough.
